



Cathedral Quarter is transforming Westgate through heritage-led regeneration

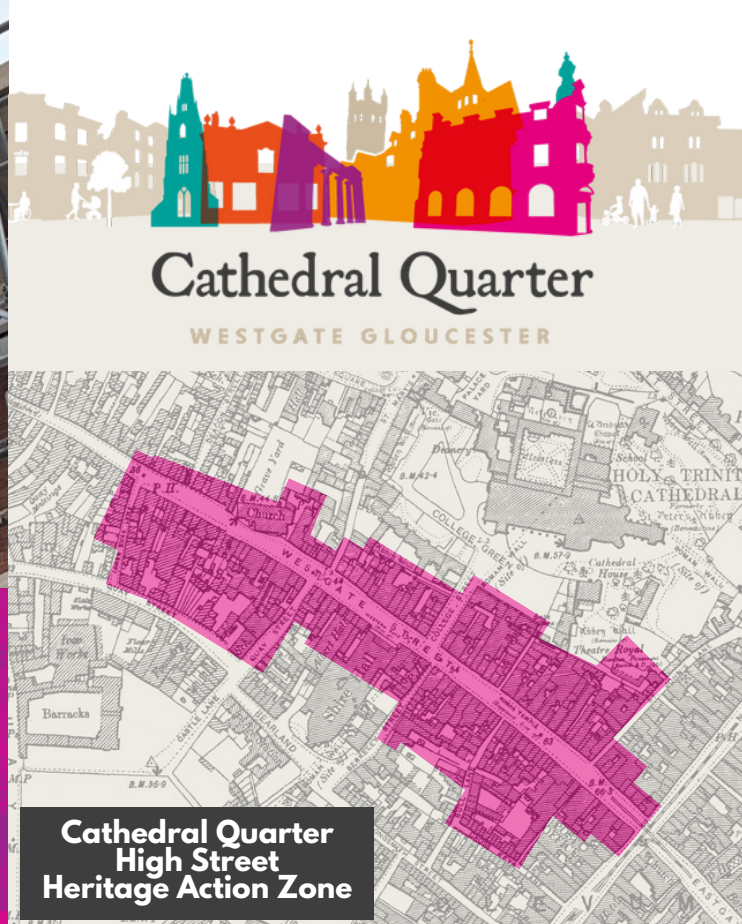
We've already funded major works to historic buildings up and down the street.

Here's what we do

We host a rich cultural programme, appointing artists in residence to host workshops and run creative projects with the local community.

We help heritage at risk with emergency and structural repairs, including the early timber frame at 41 Westgate Street, the former Theatre Royal at 32-34 Westgate Street, and to Shire Hall.

We're funding major works to historic buildings up and down the street, including early stage works to the medieval Fleece Hotel, paving the way for its planned transformation.

We've also undertaken facade repairs to the Dick Whittington and Folk of Gloucester, brought empty space back into use at 14 and 39 Westgate Street.

We've staged public exhibitions to celebrate Gloucester's fantastic history such as 3D Archaeology, Windows Through Time, and Historic Gloucester in Lego at the Folk.

We're reinstating traditional shopfronts and fascia signage. We've already done the Cathedral Quarter hub at 21 Westgate Street and a new Critall-style period-appropriate shopfront at 29 Westgate Street. Work is in progress to put a traditional shopfront and upper floor at 88 Westgate, bringing it into line with the rest of the street.

We're looking for more proposals to restore more historic shops in the area, so get in touch to see what we can do for you.

Working with urban designers and landscape architects McGregor Coxall, we've produced plans to improve the street scene in Westgate with more seating and trees, better lighting, slower and safer traffic, and spaces to socialise and relax.
